2. God exalts **Samuel** in answer to the **nation's** misery (2:12–4:1)

- 3. God exalts Jesus in answer to our misery
- His mercy extends to those who fear him, from generation to generation.
  He has performed mighty deeds with his arm;
- he has scattered those who are proud in their inmost thoughts.
- <sup>52</sup> He has brought down rulers from their thrones but has lifted up the humble.

- 2. How does understanding that "The LORD brings death and makes alive; he brings down to the grave and raises up" (2:6) encourage me?
